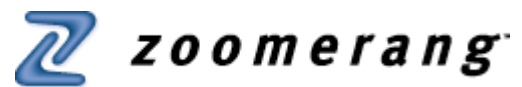





15. What percentage of your work is done on a paid basis?









